
1. Situation. This command has received credible information that Tokyo Shoten Bookstores currently sell DVDs containing sexually explicit material involving children under the age of ten. Tokyo Shoten Bookstores' reported activities constitute a threat to the health, safety and welfare of our SOFA personnel. Furthermore, I consider the reported activities a threat to good order, discipline and the morals of our military and civilian communities.

2. Order. Pursuant to reference (a), effective immediately, Tokyo Shoten Bookstores, located on Highway 23 at 820-6 Kamisedo, Chatan Cho, Okinawa Prefecture as depicted in enclosure (1) and on Highway 43 at Wakasa Building, 2-1-7 Wakasa, Naha City, Okinawa Prefecture as depicted in enclosure (2) are off-limits to all MCBJ/III MEF SOFA status personnel and dependents. This includes all military members, civilian personnel (GS, NSPS and contractor), and all dependents and applies to personnel attached permanently or in a TAD status. This order will remain in effect until superseded or cancelled. This order constitutes a lawful general order, and is punitive in nature. Penalties for violations of this order include the full range of statutory and regulatory sanctions for civilian

and military personnel. The sole exception to this order is personnel entering Tokyo Shoten Bookstores in the performance of their official duties.

3. Dissemination. Subordinate commanders are directed to ensure that this order receives the widest possible dissemination. Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Board (AFDCB) procedures outlined in the reference have been initiated.


