<b>Summary of duties:</b> Identifies different types of storage batteries and determines charging rate for batteries, taking into consideration factors such as condition of plates, state of charge, and method of charging. Place batteries on charges and varies charging rate to compensate for varying conditions such as excessive grassing, overheating, and overflow of electrolyte. Adjusts specific gravity of electrolyte in batteries by adding distilled water or electrolyte, charging batteries for short period and / or testing electrolyte. Prepares electrolyte by mixing sulphuric acid in water. Performs daily checks of all Hazardous Waste/material Storage areas and oil/water separators to ensure they meet the criteria set forth in the Base used oil and hazardous waste management order and the JEGS (Japan Environmental Governing Standards). Checks all hazardous material received to ensure a printed Material Safety Date Sheet (MSDS) or a record from the HMIS database is with the material and in the master file.

Must be familiar with hazardous material and hazardous waste management, to include storage, control, and accountability.</li><li>2.
