PRIVACY ACT ADVISORY

AUTHORITY: 5 U.S.C. 301, Departmental Regulations and 5 U.S.C. 552a, Privacy Act, 10 U.S.C. 5041, Headquarters, Marine Corps; E.O. 9397, November 1943 (SSN); and Secretary of the Navy Instruction 5211.5E, Department of the Navy Privacy Program.
