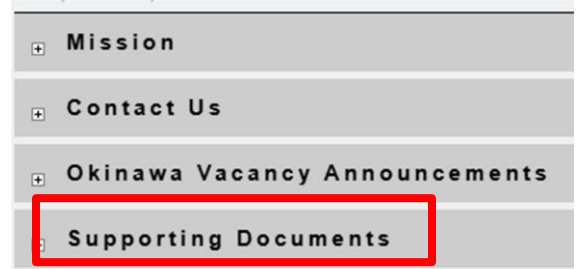

<p>Summary of duties: The incumbent receives daily work assignments in the form of service tickets and assigns work requests, preventative maintenance work orders and verbal communication from the Foreman A and/or U.S. Supervisor.</p> <p>Incumbent will install, modify, test, repair, trouble shoot, and maintain transformers, converters, regulators, cables, switches, circuit breakers, and other circuit elements found in breaker/switch house facilities. Installs, modifies, connects, inspects, trouble shoots, and repair overhead/underground electrical distribution lines up to 13.8KV. The incumbent will service lines, substations, transformers, insulators, capacitor equipment, lighting arresters, re-closers, switches, fuses, ground connects, and similar equipment.</p> <p>Incumbent will install, modify and replace distribution equipment in breaker/switch houses, transformer vaults, stations, houses, and distribution centers. Cleans, adjusts, and repairs electrical equipment such as air and oil circuit breakers. Constructs and installs rigid conduits. Pulls in conductors, assembles bus bars, and phases out and connects conductors. Incumbent will troubleshoot distribution circuits and controlling equipment to locate and correct the causes of outages and improper operation. Make emergency cutouts and substations of power lines and equipment.</p> <p>Monitors electronic control equipment, operates computerized diagnostic and digital test equipment as part of high voltage electrical system maintenance and troubleshooting duties. Troubleshoots overhead and underground cable systems to locate shorts, opens, grounds, crosses, electrolysis damage, capacitance imbalance, or cable breaks. Locates and marks electrical underground utilities prior to excavation.</p> <p>Incumbent will string wires and hoist conductors up to the cross arms. Pull wires to proper tension or sag based on space, length, type and size of conductors, prevailing temperature, and loading district. Install and pull cable underground from source of feed-through ducts. Checks condition of transformers, switches, capacitor equipment, and cables. Test insulating oil from transformers and oil switches for breakdown and contamination. Checks transformers operating temperatures and voltage at secondary terminals and makes repairs to defective loose, or corroded connections.</p> <p>Incumbent will visually check cracks or breaks in walls of manholes or vaults. Pumps water from manholes, removes debris, and repairs ground bonds. Checks ground wire connections and cables for cracks, breaks, corrosion, and punctures. Incumbent will install and maintain street lighting systems.</p> <p>Incumbent will inspect and test Lightning Protection Systems, maintain and repair inside and outside of plant electrical facilities, and fabricate and hang antennas.</p>
