Summary of duties:

The incumbent serves as a professional scientific specialist who has knowledge of the natural and biological sciences and a thorough knowledge of natural resource management activities in Japan. The incumbent also serves as the principal Marine Corps natural resources contact person with Japanese offices. Protection and management of natural resources include coral reefs, sea turtles and their habitat, and endangered species such as the Okinawa Rail. Area of responsibility (AOR) is 46,000 acres of Marine Corps land in 18 locations on Okinawa, to include le Shima and Tsuken Jima. Duties and responsibilities are as follows:

Performs field checks and data gathering to assess/mitigate environmental impacts of proposed site construction/repair work requests, updates natural resource inventories, and inspects joint US-GOJ projects or training activities that could impact conservation/habitat areas within AOR.

Assists the implementation of the Natural Resource Management Plan including threatened/endangered species profiles; monitoring operational impacts on wetlands, forests, water areas, and other natural resources; and coordination of outdoor recreation issues.

Using computer data management and electronic mapping knowledge and skills compatible with the G-F geographic information system, establishes and maintains databases that support data storage and technical analysis.

Researches, analyzes, and translates scientific information from Japanese government documents, scientific journals/reports, online sources, and media sources.

Interprets during meetings between the US Natural Resource Manager and Japanese scientific personnel and maintains liaison with Japanese universities and government offices at the national, prefectural, and local levels to facilitate information exchange.

- 2. Demonstratable experience working to provide conservation and protection of species of concern in Japan.
