This program requires participation in **144 hours** of live and virtual coach-specific training, practice, and other assignments. An official course syllabus will be distributed after approval of enrollment.

Trainees must attend 12 full days of in-person classroom training scheduled from **9:00am—5:00pm** on the following dates:

- Segment I:** June 4 - 7, 2019
- Segment II:** August 27-30, 2019
- Segment III:** November 19-22, 2019
- Graduation Seminar and Ceremony:** January TBD, 2020

I acknowledge that the Federal Internal Coach Training Program is a rigorous 8-month program that will prepare participants to educate, promote, and foster a coaching culture within the Federal Government and agree to support the participation of my employee to the best of my ability.

I understand this agreement in no way limits my ability to schedule his/her work. Further, I understand that s/he will keep me informed about the Federal Internal Coach Training Program assignments and requirements. I also understand that once selected, participants are required to:

1. Attend 12 full days of in-person training
2. Coach 4 individuals for a minimum of 6 hours each
3. Participate in one (1) virtual training session per month
4. Participate in two (2) mentor coaching sessions for 90 minutes each per month
5. Receive at least 6 hours of coaching
6. Complete at least five (5) observed coaching sessions; three (3) will be recorded
7. Complete an oral exam demonstrating learned coaching skills
8. Write a Reflection Paper of learning and observations
9. Complete all other course requirements

I understand that after graduation, each Federal Internal Coach commits to coach other Federal employees in support of establishing a culture of coaching throughout Government. All future coaching engagements need to be approved by me based on organizational priorities. All coaching activities in no way will affect the classification of official duties of positions under my direct supervision.

I also understand this program is at no cost to the agency, other than the participant's regular salary or travel costs. All classroom training will be held in the **Washington DC Metro area**.
