Subj: PRISONER CHASER COURSE

1. Prisoner chaser courses are held upon request. A minimum of ten students must be present in order to conduct the course. All students are required to bring military identification, pen, and notepad. The student must meet the following criteria:

- a. Must not have been subject to any Non-Judicial Proceedings or court-martials during current enlistment.
- b. Must be at least 19 years of age.
- c. Must be an E-2 or above.
- d. Must have never been confined in any Military Confinement Facility (MCF).
- e. Must have at least 3 months of active duty service.
- f. Must have a GT score of at least 100 (cannot be waived.)
- g. Must be mentally and emotionally stable.
- h. Must have no physical or speech impediments.
- i. Must not be pending any administrative separation, punitive discharge, or currently under investigation.

2. The command is responsible for screening the nominated student prior to the student attending the course. The student's OIC or SNCOIC must sign paragraph (4) of this document verifying all student requirements are met and recommend the student be nominated for this course. If any student attending fails to meet one of the above requirements, the student will be dropped from course and the student's command will be notified.
