Subj: ACTIVE DUTY SERVICE MEMBER VISIT

Ref: (a) SECNAV M-1640.1

1. In accordance with the references, any active duty service member who wishes to visit a post or pre-trial prisoner confined at the Marine Corps Installations Pacific Brig, Okinawa, Japan must obtain the following endorsement and approval from their Company Commander or higher.

2. The following visitation guidelines apply to all visitors and will be adhered to by all service members, for additional details refer to the references provided:

- a. Visitation hours are from 1300-1500 (Saturday, Sunday, Holidays, and days within the holiday period)
- b. Unmarried visitor under the age of 18 must be accompanied by their parent or legal guardian.
- c. Married prisoners will not visit with visitors of the opposite sex that are not their spouse unless the visitor is accompanied by the prisoner's spouse or the visitors' spouse.
- d. A married visitor will not be permitted to visit any prisoner of the opposite sex who is not their spouse without being accompanied by their spouse unless they are a relative (i.e. cousin, sister, or mother)

3. Forms must be completed and returned to the Brig no later than 1300 on the last working day prior to the service member's first visit.
